Once downloaded, students can fill out the application and then print out a typed copy. Please be sure to include all information requested is included in your packet prior to submission.

Verification of high school transcript and grade rank will be required. It is also **EXTREMELY** important to complete the Honor Pledge & Contact Sheet in order to for your application to be considered.

DIRECTIONS FOR THE LINDENHURST JR. SQUIRES SOCCER SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

PLEASE FOLLOW ALL DIRECTIONS EXACTLY OR YOUR APPLICATION WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED!

1. All application information and essay must be **TYPED!** Students may use a typewriter or download an application from any computer by clicking on the local scholarship link at www.lindenhurstsoccer.org. Once downloaded, students can fill out the application and then print out a typed copy.
2. Signatures of the student and parent/guardian are **REQUIRED** and must be **signed in DARK INK** on Page 3 (the Honor Pledge) of the application. Additionally, the Applicant Overview page – Counselor Section must be signed and verified by your Guidance Counselor at your current High School.
3. Each student is **required to provide a personal statement or essay about him or herself**. This may include information about future plans, goals or any additional information that may be helpful to the committee in evaluating the student as a candidate.
4. **DO NOT place your name or contact information on any page** with the exception of the Contact & Honor Page Pledge.
5. Each student must submit the application packet in it's entirety by deadline dates announced.

Lindenhurst High School Seniors must submit their application through the Local Scholarship packet provided by the Guidance Dept by Friday, March 7, 2014.

Seniors that do not attend Lindenhurst High School must submit their application to our Lindenhurst Jr. Squires Soccer League, PO Box 611, Lindenhurst, NY 11757. Your packet must be postmarked by Monday, March 10, 2014.
